



On above screen, click on a square and it will get a green outline, then select Front door or Garage Click on a different square and select the other camera. These pictures are live. Click on Search to replay any of the files.

Most computers will work without any further setup. Some may need some settings altered , so have a go and see what you get.

First time installation of this viewer will take several minutes on your computer, and is affected by broadband speed and other traffic.

The router at our end has to be switched on. It is often switched off which is a sensible security precaution. You can email us at info@haddenalarms.co.uk to check that the router is on if you have any problems and we will leave it on for several days.

Although these cameras are at my house, feel free to browse around the system – that is why I set it up.

These systems also allow the user to view local cameras on their premises on a

- 1. Monitor
- 2. TV
- 3. Intranet Connection (ie on your computer)

These three options don't need an Internet connection and you can have all three connected at your premises if you require this.
